The Randolph Caldecott Medal annually recognizes the preceding year's "most distinguished American picture book for children", beginning with 1937 publications. Caldecott Medal Winner. The 2000 Caldecott Medal winner is Joseph Had a Little Overcoat by Simms Taback (Viking). "Joseph Had a Little Overcoat," is the story of a resourceful and resilient tailor who transforms his worn-out overcoat into smaller and smaller garments. A complete list of Caldecott medal and honor books from 1938 to present. The medal is awarded annually by the Association for Library Service to Children, to the artist of the most distinguished American picture book for children. This is a two week unit designed to introduce K-2 students to the art work in Caldecott Medal and Honor books.
