Stones to Stains: The Drawings of Victor Hugo is made possible by lead support from Alice and Nahum Lainer. Major support is provided by Deanie and Jay Stein and the LLWW Foundation. Few nineteenth-century figures are as towering as the French poet, novelist, playwright, critic, and politician Victor Hugo (1802–1885). Though he is remembered mostly for his literary achievements, particularly *The Hunchback of Notre-Dame* (1831) and *Les Misérables* (1862), he excelled at drawing. This exhibition sheds new light on Hugo's experimental and enigmatic practice as a draftsman and includes over 75 drawings and photographs spanning the duration of his career. Accompanying a major exhibition, this book brings together around ninety of Victor Hugo's most significant works on paper. It features previously unpublished drawings and insightful texts that reveal the author's extraordinary talents as a draftsman., *Stones To Stains The Drawings Of Victor Hugo*.
