

Download To Change The Church Pope Francis And The Future Of Catholicism

A side-by-side comparison with Cardinal Martini's words for how the Church should change and Pope Francis' own words reveals a striking similarity. When he retired, the ultra-conservative Pope Benedict XVI was expected to disappear from view, clearing the way for his liberal successor, Francis, to clean house in the notoriously corrupt Vatican. Argentine Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio was elected the Roman Catholic Church's 266th Pope on March 13, 2013. The first pontiff from Latin America was also the first to take the name Francis.
